Find out in playwright Terrence McNally's masterful dark comedy which brings to life ghosts of the past as it lays bare secrets of the heart. If you love plays that walk a fine line between laugh-out-loud comedy and truth-telling drama, this one is for you!

Four beloved South Bay actors—Joey McDaniel, Alicia Teeter, Mary Melnick, and Michael Rhone—come together for a reading of a play about privileged, white, straight couples coming to understand that the HIV/AIDS epidemic is not just touching the lives of gay men and intravenous drug users. Set in the early 1990s, when the rate of infection was still not under control and the death toll was continuing to rise, *Lips Together, Teeth Apart* humorously explores the folly of people who think their wealth and position protects them from the realities of the world in which we live. Admission is free, but the show is a fundraiser for The Health Trust, a local HIV/AIDS Services program that provides an array of safety net services for our neighbors living with HIV in the South Bay Area. This highly rated non-profit provides home-delivered meals, HIV and chronic illness care management, and housing support right here in Santa Clara County. Donations are encouraged.
